Upper Oconee Basin Water Authority Bear Creek Dam, Reservoir and Water Treatment Facilities Operation and Maintenance Report March 22, 2023

Plant continues to operate within regulatory requirements with no issues since last meeting.

Reservoir level - Full Pool at 695.00

Average daily treated water flow of 7.43 MGD of potable water pumped to the distribution system in February.

We are utilizing the latest demand projections provided by the Member Governments in the drought model for the Weekly Reservoir Report. A summary of projections versus actual for each MG is provided as Attachment A for review.

Procurement

- Awarded landscaping service contract beginning February.
- Approved to begin PLC upgrades in Chemical/Admin. building.
- Working with ACC and Siemens to upgrade Reservoir pump drives.

Major Maintenance

- Replaced stream and current monitor for plant optimization.
- Replaced radio communication system for dam outflow, (Transmitters and Antennae)
- Drive cell rebuilt for ACC reservoir pump #5.
- Installed new caustic soda feed pump.

Additional Activity

- Georgia EPD sanitary survey conducted March 9th.
- Preparing to begin high rate filtration study for ultimate plant expansion capacity.
- Liquid Lime and CO2 full scale trial conducted January 20th-February 17th.
- Annual Chlorine system maintenance and backflow inspections scheduled.
- SPX flow representative completed complimentary analysis on all Philadelphia flocculators and mixers.
