PGS DIVISION WILL HOST MOBILE WORKSHOP AT THE GEORGIA BIKE-WALK-LIVE SUMMIT

On November 18th, the NEGRC's Planning & Government Services (PGS) staff will lead an interactive mobile workshop for the Georgia Bike-Walk-Live Summit in partnership with the Georgia Department of Transportation (GDOT). Participants will be utilizing wheelchairs to conduct an audit of select sidewalks in downtown Athens on North Thomas Street. This informative mobile workshop serves to draw attention to wheelchair accessibility while also teaching how to collect data and implement solutions to improve active transportation conditions for all people living in the community.

The 2023 Georgia Bike-Walk-Live Summit is presented by Bike Law Georgia at the Graduate in Athens, GA. The Summit begins with a welcome event, followed by pedestrian safety curriculums and crash screening analysis programs, including fun and informative mobile workshops throughout Athens.

The mobile workshop, led by the NEGRC's PGS staff, will provide an interactive approach to disability awareness.

ARC AWARDS GRANT TO MADISON COUNTY FOR WATER STUDY

The Appalachian Regional Commission (ARC) recently awarded Madison County \$77,000 to conduct a feasibility study into options for the county's long-term water and wastewater delivery systems. This planning study will provide an overall framework for the county's water system by identifying the county's water needs, future water sources, and ways to prioritize funding for projects to accommodate the expected growth of the county. The grant application was developed and submitted by the NEGRC's Planning & Government Services (PGS) staff on behalf of Madison County and at their request.

THE CAREGIVER OF THE YEAR CELEBRATION

The Northeast Georgia Area Agency on Aging (AAA) Care-Net will host its annual "Caregiver of the Year" Celebration at Trumps' Catering on November 8, 2023, at 11:00 a.m. Trumps' Catering is located at 2026 South Milledge Avenue B, Athens, Georgia 30605.

The "Caregiver of the Year" Award recognizes selfless acts, compassion, empathy, effort, and extraordinary commitment of caregivers toward those who need their care. We believe it is essential to honor those who sacrifice their own resources, time, comfort, and sometimes livelihoods for the good of others. To be eligible for the award, a caregiver must be currently providing care or must have provided care within the past year.

The Award Categories are as follows:

Family Caregiver Award

Nominees accepted:

- Any family member who provides assistance to a person with a disability, chronic illness, or other condition requiring support and assistance to have a full life in the community.
- A non-relative, but perceived as family, such as neighbor or friend.

Para-Professional Caregiver Award

Nominees accepted:

- Licensed Practical Nurse (LPN)
- Therapy aide
- · Home Health Aide
- Certified Nursing Assistant (CNA)
- Nurse's Aide/Patient Care Technician
- Direct Support Caregiver (companion/sitter)

Volunteer Caregiver Award

Nominees Accepted:

- A volunteer who has completed at least one year of service caring for an individual or individuals in a capacity that aids and/or improves their life. For example, Hospice Volunteer, Church Volunteer, and Volunteer with an Association such as Alzheimer's or Parkinson's.
- A volunteer who has been involved in an event or situation that has made a real difference in the life of a care receiver or their family.

Congratulations to the nine recent graduates of the Foothills Barrow/WorkSource Northeast Georgia WeldReady course, held at the Foothills Sims-Barrow County Campus. This collaboration involved Foothills Regional High School, the Northeast Georgia Regional Commission/ WorkSource Georgia, and Workforce Innovators, Inc. The training provided ten weeks of instruction in welding and related employment preparation.

The October 2023 graduates received certification in OSHA 10, Lean Six-Sigma White Belt, First Aid/CPR/AED, Basic Forklift Operation, and American Welding Society (AWS Certification). These young individuals are now prepared to enter the workforce and are actively interviewing for jobs with local companies. Funding is provided through WorkSource Northeast Georgia, thanks to a USDOL WORC ARC grant and a United Way of Northeast Georgia grant.
