Topics include all aspects of financial management and planning of a water system fund including rates and rate setting, controlling costs, planning for capital expenses, accessing external funding (loans and grants), tracking and benchmarking financial performance, and other Enterprise Fund issues that small water systems face.

You will learn how to:

- Set aside funds for future repairs, security upgrades, and regulatory compliance
- Set fair rates that cover costs
- Locate external funding sources (loans and grants)
- Monitor financial performance

This workshop is designed for water systems serving 10,000 or fewer people (though systems of any size may attend), and is particularly targeted to local government systems facing financial challenges.
